1. Any Time Pg 8

Intro: 1st two notes are single strum and slow (same at bottom of page 1) ...Ending: Repeat last line from "...that's the time..." and end with single strums F C

2. Are You Lonesome Tonight Pg 10

Intro: tacet until "...lonesome...Note: play through the song twice, end with a tremolo

3. Back in the Saddle Again Pg 12

Begin on 2nd page "...whoo pi ti yi yo...", play the song all the way through from there, and end with an F C

4. Bye Bye Love Pg 14

Begin: tacet until "...baby..."

Note: after last verse go back to the top of the 2nd page C7 "...bye bye love...Ending: F(5) C7 F

5. Don't Fence Me In Pg 24

Begin on Pg 2 tacet "...I want to..."

End: Repeat "...don't fence me in..." 3X, end with A7 D

6. Hey Good Lookin' Pg 40 No Special Remarks

7. I Fall to Pieces Pg 44

Intro: C(4) F(2) G7(2)

Note: Can replace combo on 2^{nd} and 4^{th} lines with G , then slide down one fret

8. I'm So Lonesome I Could Cry Pg 46

Ending: After 2nd verse, repeat "I'm so lonesome I could cry" to end

9. King of the Road Pg 48

Notes: tacet 3rd line "I ain't got no cigarettes...", tacet 2nd line pg 2 "king of the road...", tacet last line on pg

Ending: 3X "....king of the road", then G C G

10. Ring of Fire Pg 56

Notes: Pg 2 line 2 soften "...and it burns, burns, burns..."

Ending: Repeat 3X, fading

11. <u>Rocky Top</u> Pg 58

Ending: Repeat "Rocky Top, Tennessee" 3X, then C(5) F C

12. Walkin' After Midnight Pg 74

Notes: At the end, after "...searching for me..." return to C7 on top line and play

to end

13. Your Cheatin' Heart Pg 78

Intro: G(5) single stroke, then tacet

Notes: tacet "...but sleep won't.." 3rd line

tacet "...you'll walk the floor..."pg 2, 4th line

tacet ",,,Your cheatin'..." last line pg 2

Ending: last note, slide down and back
