Intro: G x 4

Verse 1:

G C D7 G
Up every day at six, bacon and eggs to fix
G C D7/ - Tacet
Four kids from one to four, Pretty soon there'll be one more, I got
G C D7 G
Old floors to wax and scrub, and there's a dirty old ring in the tub

G G7 C D7// Tacet G
I'll get a maid some-day, but till then I'm Queen of the House

Verse 2:

G C D7 G
No time to fix my hair, need a new dress to wear
G C D7/ - Tacet
Old clothes will have to do, 'cause the kids all need new shoes
G C D7 G
I got bridge club each Tuesday night, he goes out with the boys and gets tight
G G7 C D7// Tacet G
But when the eve-ning's through he comes home to the Queen of the House
