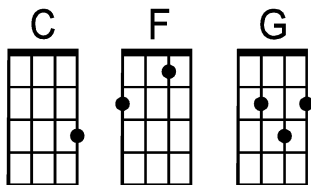


Down on the Corner

Intro: Riff #1 x 2, Riff#2, Riff#1

C G C
 Early in the evenin', just around supper time
 C G C
 Over at the courthouse they're starting to un-wind
 F C
 Four kids on the corner, trying to bring you up
 G C
 Willy picks a tune out and he blows it on the harp.

Chorus: F C G C
 Down on the corner, out in the street
 F C
 Willy and the Poorboys are playin'
 G C
 Bring a nickel, tap your feet

C G C
 Rooster hits the washboard, and people just gotta smile
 C G C
 Blinky thumps the gut bass and solos for a while
 F C
 Poorboy twangs the rhythm out on his Kalamazoo
 G C
 And Willy goes in to a dance and doubles on ka-zoo.
