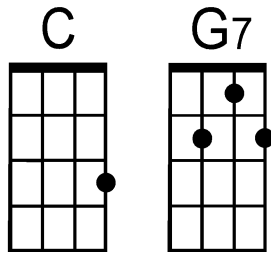


Buffalo Gals
