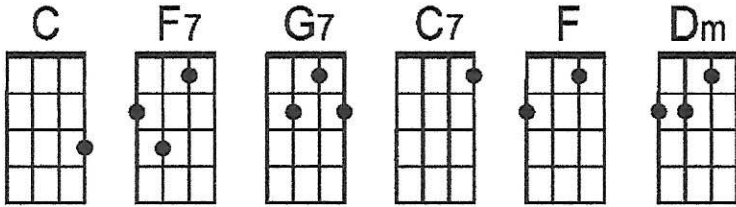


Walkin' After Midnight
