Written by <u>Lincoln Chase</u>, and was first recorded by American <u>R&B</u> singer <u>LaVern Baker</u> (1955). In 1956, it reached the top of the <u>R&B</u> chart^[2] and #17 on the <u>pop</u> charts in the United States. It was named one of The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame's 500 Songs that Shaped Rock and Roll.

In 1973 the song was recorded by <u>southern rock</u> band <u>Black Oak Arkansas</u>. It hit #25 on the pop chart that year.

A version by the Wright Brothers Band was used in the 1987 film Overboard.
